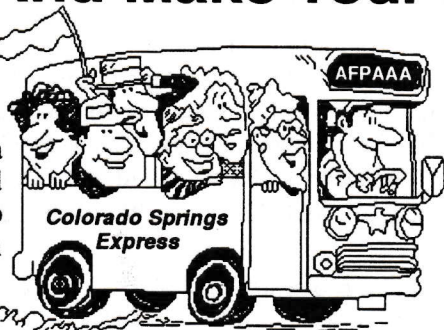


# Guess Who You'll See In Colorado Springs; Read On And Make Your Reservations Now !

## 5 Strong Candidates Vie For 4 Board Seats

Ballots accompany this newsletter to full members in good standing to vote for Association Directors. To be counted they must be postmarked by June 1.

Full members in good standing are retired or separated, military or civilian who served in either Public Affairs or Broadcasting in the active, guard, or reserve force whose dues are current. New board members will be announced at the Association's meeting in Colorado Springs, June 17.

There are five strong candidates running for four two-year seats in this election. They are: Al Eakle, whose career included service in the Persian Gulf, winning Air Force newspaper and photo

awards, and coordination of Thunderbird airshows. He retired as a Master Sergeant with almost 21 years of service. Al is President of Spirit of America Airshows.

Jim Hart retired as a Brigadier General this year. He was the mobilization assistant to the Director of Public Affairs. He became an officer through the Outstanding Airman Commissioning program in 1965. Jim is a Lifetime Founder Member and our publications chairman. He is Vice President of Public

Kathy McCollum was an executive and protocol officer before entering public affairs. Her assignments included Electronic Systems Division, and as the Air Force District of Washington's first

PAO. She retired as a major.

Today she is a senior program analyst at Coleman Research Corp. Kathy is a Lifetime Founder Member.

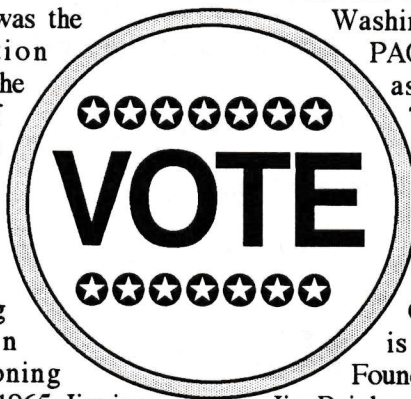
Jim Reinhard is a member of the current board, one of the seven people who founded the Association, and is a Lifetime
